Once on the site, please select the tab for BBEC and follow the on screen instructions. Payment is made directly to the company via the website order. Hoodies will be sent to school and we will hand these out before the end of term.

The deadline to order hoodies by is Monday 3 May 2021 to allow time for printing and delivery.

### Year 11 Prom

As long as the government's road map continues to progress as anticipated, the prom should be able to go ahead. If government guidelines change, we may sadly have to cancel it. In order for students to be able to attend prom, there are some criteria they must meet. Between Tuesday 20 April 2021 and the date year 11 leave, they need to ensure they have:

- **No more than 30 negative behaviour points\***
- **Attendance of 96% or more\***

\*Please note, school reserves the right to cancel a student's prom ticket at our discretion.

Furthermore, students can also secure themselves a discount on prom tickets by having:

- **100% attendance and 0 behaviour points = a free ticket**
- **98%+ attendance and 0 behaviour points = £20 discount**
- **96%+ attendance and 0 behaviour points = £10 discount**

Anyone who does not fall into these categories will pay £30 each for their ticket.

As this is a special occasion, we would like students to dress smartly. We do however realise that given the circumstances this year, this has been booked at short notice and still isn't guaranteed to go ahead. Therefore, we do not expect parents and carers to go out and spend large amounts of money.

Students are welcome to wear a full formal prom outfit, or can wear smart clothes they already have. If your child would like to go to the prom but you have concerns about finance, please contact either Miss White or Mrs Ford.

Tickets will go on sale from 28 May 2021 and can be bought via Parent Pay. If your child is eligible to go, you will have the link on there to be able to buy the ticket. The price of the ticket will include any discount earned by your child. In the event that prom is cancelled due to changes in government guidelines, a full refund will be issued.
