Dear Parents/Carers

Industrial Action 5 and 7 July

As you may be aware, members of the National Education Union (NEU) will be taking industrial action in the form of a strike on **Wednesday 5 and Friday 7 July**, meaning that school will be closed to the majority of students as there will not be sufficient staff for us to supervise them safely.

We will, as we have done previously, be contacting the parents and carers of identified students separately to this letter, as we will still be hosting provision for certain groups of students.

If you have not received this separate communication by the end of Tuesday 27 June, please note that the school will not be open for your child on Wednesday 5 or Friday 7 July, and we will be providing remote learning for them to complete at home.

Again, as previously, if you are a critical worker and would like your child to attend on either of these days, please email school separately to request provision.

On Wednesday 5 July, school will be closed to all students, other than those above. This will be our transition day, during which Year 6 students will be attending. If you are the parent/carer of a student who is starting BBEC in September, please refer to the separate letter from Miss David, which details the arrangements for both the students during the day and the transition evening.

On Friday 7 July, school will be open to Year 8 students only, in addition to those invited separately. The timings of the day will be as follows:

- 10.00 Lesson 2
- 10.35 Break
- 10.50 Lesson 3
- 11.30 Progress test 2
- 12.50 Lunch
- 1.20 Lesson 5
- 2.20 Finish
