Loops	Pre-recorded short sounds
Loop	Extending the part a number of times
Track	Individual 'lane' of music
Part	The single block of sound
Play	Starts the sounds playing
Stop	Stops the sounds
Mix	Overall sound of the piece
Volume	How loud/soft
Automation	The computer is programmed to carry out certain functions
Split	Cuts the part
Merge	Glues the parts back together
Record	Records what you play/say/sing
Quantise	Moves the notes in time with your value
