This support has enabled Forest Carbon to plant 4 new trees, creating a new woodland area of 24 square metres at Doddington North, Wooler, Northumberland, England.

The re-usable water bottles have arrived and almost 200 students and staff have purchased them, potentially preventing thousands of plastic bottles from being purchased and brought into school. Here are the bottles shown by myself (Mr Ryan) and Mrs Sweeney:



We have also now introduced 15 recycled bins in all staff areas, which replace the many varied bins - the contents of which were normally destined for landfill.
