









Year 7 – A Midsummer Night’s Dream– Learn Sheet

	<p>Oberon- King of the fairies. <i>Fell out with Titania because he wanted the changeling boy as a servant. He also accuses her of having an affair with Theseus. When they fell out, the seasons became mixed up. Oberon gets Robin Goodfellow, his puck fairy servant, to put magic juice in Titania’s eyes so that she falls in love with Bottom. Robin also transforms Bottom’s head into a donkey’s (ass’s) head.</i></p>
	<p>Titania - Queen of the fairies. <i>Adopted a changeling after her friend died. The changeling is half human and half fairy. She accuses Oberon of having an affair with Hippolyta.</i></p>
	<p>Robin Goodfellow (Puck) – puck fairy. <i>Mischievous. Carries out Oberon’s plans and adds a few pranks of his own.</i></p>
	<p>Hermia - Athenian. <i>Loves Lysander. Runs off into the woods with Lysander as her father wanted her to marry Demetrius. Falls out with Helena when Robin uses the love juice to make both men love Helena. Calls Helena a: “thief of love”. She is short and Helena insults her by calling her a “puppet”.</i></p>
	<p>Helena - Athenian. <i>Loves Demetrius. At the end, the love juice is used to make him love her back. She is very tall and Hermia insults her by calling her a “painted maypole”.</i></p>
	<p>Lysander – Athenian. <i>Loves Hermia but isn’t allowed to marry her at first.</i></p>
	<p>Demetrius – Athenian. <i>Also loves Hermia but later loves and marries Helena.</i></p>
	<p>Bottom – Mechanical. <i>Wants all the attention in the play that he is performing in for the duke. Turned into an ass. Loved by Titania because of the love juice.</i></p>

Allowing yourself to be controlled by other people.



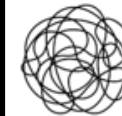
Obsessed

Year 7 – Ruby Bridges– Learn Sheet



Ruby Bridges – In the 1950s, she went to one of the first desegregated schools in America. She had to deal with protesting white parents who shouted racist abuse at her and refused to send their children to the school. One mother threatened to poison her.



Mrs Henry – Ruby’s first white teacher. She was also a friend to Ruby. She had a Boston accent that Ruby copied.

Context

Segregation: once slavery came to an end, some areas of America still treated black people as second-class citizens. This inequality was seen in segregated societies where black and white people were kept separate from one another in places such as:

- Businesses
- Public transport
- Sports teams
- Cafes and restaurants
- Water fountains
- Schools
- Housing



A court case known as Brown vs. Board of Education resulted in schools being desegregated. This was when Ruby Bridges first attended a mixed school.
