LOCKDOWN PROCEDURE

'Lockdown' means locking doors and windows to keep people safe inside a building

- 1. When a lockdown is signalled (10 beeps over tannoy system), stay in your classroom.
- 2. Lock the classroom door and windows or place furniture against the door to stop access.
 - 3. Cover windows, draw blinds and turn off lights.
 - 4. Remain calm.
- 5. Stay in your classroom you may be told to sit on the floor, underneath a table or against a wall (sit in a place where you can be least seen).
 - 6. Remain silent, do not use your mobile phone.
 - 7. Listen carefully and follow staff instructions at all times.
- 8. Do not leave the classroom until a member of staff says it is ok or the 'all clear' signal has been given, even if the fire alarm sounds
