

Consultation on proposed changes to Admission Policy 2021/2022

Buttershaw Business and Enterprise College is consulting on the following proposed changes to its admission policy from September 2021.

A fresh over subscription criteria has been created which is different to the current over subscription criteria.

1. The differences in the over subscription criteria for In-Year transfers are:
 - The geographical extension of the catchment area
 - Priority given to students from other BDAT academies
2. The differences in the over subscription criteria for Year 7 are:
 - The geographical extension of the catchment area
 - Priority given to students from other BDAT academies

The consultation period is from 6th December 2019 until 24th January 2020 and we invite comments both from existing parents and any other interested parties.
