




## Uniform

When students start school they should be in **full school uniform**.

- BBEC blazer
- White shirt (not blouse)
- **Correct colour** striped BBEC tie
- **Correct colour** BBEC jumper
- **Tailored trousers with school logo** (No tight or stretchy trousers allowed. Students will be expected to borrow trousers for the day to avoid them missing learning and parents will be asked to change inappropriate trousers for the following day)
- **Plain black leather or leather type shoes with no logos or different colour soles** (no trainers - students will be expected to borrow shoes for the day to avoid them missing learning and parents will be asked to change inappropriate shoes for the following day)



## BBEC PE kit consists of

- BBEC t-shirt with school logo (black)
- BBEC tracksuit bottoms with school logo (black) or BBEC shorts with school logo (black)
- BBEC PE hoodie may also be worn but this is optional. (Non-school hoodies and coats are not acceptable)
- Training shoes (football boots are optional when using the grass or AstroTurf)



Students must always bring kit, even if they are excused from PE.

- Students will be expected to take some part in the lesson, even if they are not 'playing'.
- The only exception to this is if an injury prevents your child from easily getting changed. (If they have a pot on their leg, for example)
- If students do not bring your kit, they will be expected to borrow kit from school and parents will be notified.

## Lockers

Students will have access to a personal locker each day to store outdoor clothing such as coats, scarves, and shoes. It is important that students are organised and access this only at the start of the day and the start of break or lunch. No other access will be allowed as we do not want students moving around the school unsupervised.

## Equipment

It is important that each student comes **fully equipped** and ready to learn each day.

Every student must have a **large school bag** (large enough to fit an A4 folder)

They must also have their **own pencil case** with:

- 2 x pens
- 2 x pencils
- ruler
- rubber
- sharpener
- Casio scientific calculator, as illustrated



Their student planner will also become a key part of their daily equipment once this is issued on day one of the new year.

## Behaviour

We have high expectations for behaviour at BBEC and will be expecting all students to follow our code of conduct from their first day in school. **Defiance is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.** Students are expected to follow instructions **'first time, every time'**.

- **Mobile phones (and headphones)** will be confiscated if seen or heard in school.
- **Piercings** – Students may wear one small set of studs in their ears (one piercing per ear). No other piercings are allowed; this includes nose, tongue, belly button, lip etc.
- **Bracelets / Necklaces / Rings** – For health and safety reasons, students should not wear any of these items of jewellery. If students wear jewellery it will be confiscated at the doors upon arrival each day.
- **Watches** - A wristwatch is of course acceptable however smartwatches will be treated in the same way as mobile phones if they are proving to be a distraction or disrupting learning.
- **Hairstyles / Cuts** – Students are only allowed to have natural hair colours. Extreme haircuts such as under cuts, shaved lines, patterns and Mohican styles are not allowed.
- **Outdoor Clothing** - All forms of outdoor clothing including hoodies, hats and coats should not be worn in any of the school buildings, including the canteen and corridors. Lockers will be available to store outdoor clothing during the day.
- **Nails**- False nails, acrylic extensions should be short. Staff decisions on what constitutes an appropriate length is final.
- **False Eyelashes** – are not allowed at any time.
- **Make-up**, if worn should be discreet.
- **No chewing gum in school or outside in the courtyards at any time of the school day.**
- **No fizzy or energy drinks are allowed.** If brought to school, they will be confiscated and disposed of. Students should bring a water bottle or refillable container; water fountains are available for refills during social time.
