Over the next six weeks, your child's class will be taking part in lessons which will focus on relationships and sex education (RSE). RSE lessons in Year 7 will include teaching about: healthy relationships, staying safe and consent, including friendships and intimate relationships, resolving conflict; families; growing and changing, including puberty. Pupils will also have opportunities to ask questions that help prepare them for relationships of all kinds in the modern world.
