



Year 8 Uniform and Expectations

The BBEC uniform for Year 8 will be purple badged jumper and purple BBEC tie. These will be worn with a white shirt buttoned at the collar, tailored BBEC trousers with the BBEC logo on the thigh and BBEC blazer. The correct school jumper bearing the school logo must be worn under the school blazer at all times. Tight or stretchy trousers are not allowed and must not be worn. Leggings/joggers/jeggings/jeans are not acceptable.

Plain black leather school shoes should be worn every day (no logos or different coloured soles). Socks should be plain and dark in colour.

Head scarves, when worn, must be black.

Summer uniform may be worn after the Easter holiday until July and consists of a purple polo shirt instead of shirt, tie and jumper. The polo shirt is worn with the BBEC blazer.

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Student Presentation

Students should wear their uniform with pride and always have their shirts tucked in, their top buttons fastened and an appropriately fastened tie.

We expect all students to borrow correct uniform in the morning if they arrive incorrectly dressed. Defiance is never acceptable behaviour.

Jewellery, Piercings and Watches

- Only a standard watch may be worn on wrists – no smartwatch's, Apple watches' etc.
- No bracelets, Pandora chains, belchers, chains etc. to be worn in school
- Nose piercings must be replaced by a clear plastic retainer in school
- A small discreet pair of plain ear studs may be worn (one stud per ear only).

No other jewellery is allowed and will be confiscated (this includes rings, lip piercings, nose rings, eyebrow piercings, bars in ears, necklaces etc.).

For health and safety reasons any other type of body piercing is not allowed.

Hairstyles/Cuts – Students are only allowed to have natural hair colours. Extreme haircuts such as under cuts, shaved lines, patterns and Mohican styles are not allowed.

Outdoor Clothing

All forms of outdoor clothing including hoodies, hats and coats should not be worn in any of the school buildings, including the atrium, corridors and classrooms.

Nails and Eyelashes

Eyelash extensions and false eyelashes are not allowed.

False/acrylic nails must be a reasonable length.

Staff decision on what is an appropriate length is final. If they are longer, students will be provided with the opportunity to remove them or shorten them.

PE Kit

PE kit can be purchased from the uniform suppliers listed. BBEC PE kit consists of:

- BBEC t-shirt (black)
- BBEC tracksuit bottoms (black)
- BBEC shorts (black)
- BBEC PE jumper may also be worn
- Training shoes



In cold weather, students may wear layers of clothing underneath their PE kit. (If these show, they must be black in colour). **Coats must not be worn during PE lessons.**

Following Student Voice, a slimmer-legged BBEC tracksuit may now be purchased – this style is not compulsory and the older styles may still be worn. **Leggings must not be worn for PE.**

Students in the Sports Academy may wear their official Sports Academy uniform for PE lessons. Students must wear the official BBEC PE kit, no other sportswear will be allowed.

All uniform should be marked with your child's name.

Mobile Phones

- Mobile phones must be turned off in school.
- If seen, your child's mobile phone will be confiscated. It can be collected from reception at the end of the day.
- Repeated confiscations may lead to parents/carers having to collect from school
- Headphones and/or wireless earphones must not be seen in school. If they are they will be confiscated with the phone even if the phone wasn't seen/heard.
- It is a breach of GDPR and safeguarding to take photos or film other students in school. Police will be notified in all such instances.



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
